Dear Parents and Carers,

It has been lovely this week having the time to get into classrooms and chat with students about what they are learning and see how well they are working independently and co-operatively in groups. This year we will be having a strong focus on Student Agency, where students are more proactive with knowing where they are at with their learning and what they need to do to work towards the next stage. Being able to articulate this is very important and a great way for you to share with your child/ren what they have been doing throughout the day.

School Council Elections – Annual General Meeting

School Council is an important regulatory/governance body that supports and tracks our school against our priorities and targets, develops and endorses whole school policies and events. This Year we will be having our school review, which occurs every 4 years. Part of this process will be enabling our



school community opportunities to provide specific feedback about the last 4 years and what direction they would like to see in the future. School Council will play an important role during this process and is a great opportunity for parents and carers to have a voice in the future direction of the school.

At Keilor Heights Primary School, we are allowed to have 13 members on school council, consisting of 9 parent representatives and 4 staff representatives.

We are always looking for new members and encourage you to join. It is always great to have people with a range of experiences and skills on council. This year NAPLAN will be held earlier than it has been in previous years. NAPLAN tests will be completed online except for the Year 3 Writing component which will still be done by paper.



There is a 2 week period where NAPLAN tests will be carried out, March 13th – March 27th.

I am happy to say that we have been able to have the section of our Junior Playground repaired and it will be back in use after next Wednesday. Upgrading our Junior and Year 3/4 playgrounds has been raised through PFA and School Council and we plan some of our fundraising activities will go towards this so we might have new playgrounds in 2024 and 2025.

2023 CSEF Applications

Mobile Phones and Devices @ KHPS



This is a reminder that all students who choose to bring one of the following to school must have them switched off and securely stored during school hours at the office.

- mobile phones (all brands)
- wearable devices (such as smart watches, Apple watches etc)
- portable devices other than school Bring Your Own Devices

Any student who does not hand their device to the office, will have the device confiscated until a parent comes to collect it from the office.

We understand that students require devices for traveling to and from school, but families who need to contact their child, can contact the school and all information will be passed on to the child directly or to their child's teacher.





KHPS House Cross-Country/Buckley District Interschool Cross-Country Trials (Years 3-6)

This year's KHPS House Cross-Country/Buckley District Interschool Cross-Country Trials for students in years 3-6 will take place on Tuesday, April 4th (last week of term 1). On this day, all students and teachers in years 3, 4, 5 and 6 will walk down to Steele's Creek/Spring Gully Reserve in Keilor East (near Valley Lakes) to complete either the 2km run (10 years old this year and younger) or 3km (11 years old this year and older).



Students turning 10 years old or under in 2023 (born 2013, 2014 and 2015) will complete 3 x laps of approximately 670m (2km).

Every lap completed of the circuit shown will earn house points which will go towards awarding the House Cross-Country Shield for 2023.

The event is also a qualification opportunity for students (top 6 in each age group/gender) who are keen runners and have ambitions to represent KHPS at the Buckley District Cross-Country Event which will be held in Term 2, Week 2 at Brimbank Park.

Students may have different goals on the day but the focus will be on having fun, being active, and doing their best to run/walk as many laps as they can in the allocated time.


