This morning we farewelled our Year 3/4 campers and we wish all the students and staff attending well and have no doubt that they will have an amazing time.




Tuesday this week we welcomed our Foundation students for their first transition session as well as their families for an information session. It was great to see so many smiling faces and not too many tears from their parents.






