
Writing in F/1



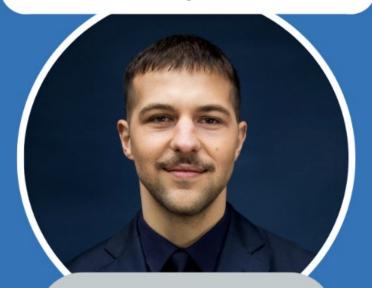
