On Monday the 17th of June, as part of our Leadership Program, students from Years 5/6 will be participating in an incursion with Motivational Speaker, Lorin Nicholson.

The competition questions are set in modern, real-world scenarios where school students are assessed on their ability to apply classroom learning to new contexts, using higher order thinking and problem-solving skills. The subjects span literacy (English, Writing and Spelling Bee) and Mathematics.

Interest for ICAS has been emailed via Compass, for those students wishing to participate in the assessments offered.

English: Week Beginning 12th August (Week 5)
