Mid-Year reports will be available for you to view on Compass Monday, 24th June. A lot of time goes into moderating various work and assessments your child has done so that teachers



can accurately provide you with a progression point and identify where your child is working at. It is important to remember that everyone learns at different rates and has different areas of strengths and areas for further development. Please take the time to read through your child's report before the Parent Teacher Interviews so that you can discuss any areas in further detail. In some cases it may be an opportunity to discuss specific areas where your child requires additional support or extension and what you can also do at home to support this.

Student Attitude to School Survey

Over the last two weeks, students in Years 4-6 have completed the Student Attitudes to School Survey. This is a survey that all students complete from Years 4-12. The survey is anonymous, however provides us with valuable feedback as to our strengths and further areas we can improve on. We usually



receive the results, along with the Staff Opinion and Parent Opinion Surveys later in Term Three and will share a summary of these results with the community. The Parent Opinion Survey will be available shortly and we strongly encourage parents to complete the survey so that we have a measurable amount of feedback to be beneficial.

YEAR 5/6










Students in Year 5/6 have been learning about sustainable farming practices in STEM. They have designed a sustainable farm and are now using different materials to make a model of their design.



The competition questions are set in modern, real-world scenarios where school students are assessed on their ability to apply classroom learning to new contexts, using higher order thinking and problem-solving skills. The subjects span literacy (English, Writing and Spelling Bee) and Mathematics.

Interest for ICAS has been emailed via Compass, for those students wishing to participate in the assessments offered.

English: Week Beginning 12th August (Week 5)

Spelling: Week Beginning 19th August (Week 6)
