Victorian State Principal Conference

On Monday, Rosie and I attended the Victorian State Principals Conference. This always provides an excellent opportunity for Principals to receive Professional Learning and hear directly from the Deputy Secretary and Minister for Education what the latest and future trends in education are. We were provided resources about the new curriculum which will be implemented in schools beginning from next year onwards and also about the new educational Learning Models.

It was recognised that many schools already follow this model as we do at KHPS. It was also reassuring to learn more about the new initiative of explicitly teaching phonics and again, an approach that we already have well embedded at KHPS.

Olympics Day - Friday 9th August

Don't forget that next Friday is our whole school Olympics Day, organised by our Year 5/6 students. Students are asked to come dressed in the country colours that has been assigned to their class. SCHOOL REFUSAL

Dear School Community

You may have already received this from the VPC's E-News, however we're just making sure you have seen the information on this very important event about School Refusal.

Join us on **Tuesday, August 6, 2024**, at 7pm for our #VPCLive event. Our distinguished panel will discuss pathways and educational alternatives to support students with school attendance challenges, including **School Refusal, School Can't and School Avoidance**. The panel includes parents, educators, psychologists, researchers, and government agencies.

The VPC advocates for parental choice in education and acknowledges that School Refusal may not accurately describe some students' experiences. Terms like School Can't or School Avoidance might be more fitting. These issues cause anxiety, academic setbacks, social isolation, and family stress, impacting children's education and mental health.

The Victorian Parents Council recognises the significant impact of school attendance issues and is convening an expert panel to explore solutions for affected families.
