When I logged on to my first VHAP meeting, I was really interested because they were actually teaching me how to make a story interesting like in the movies. I was learning about new things to use in my writing to make it more interesting. I have learnt about archetypes and why we have them, and how to use "show don't tell' by using the five senses. It prepared me for secondary school because everybody's writing has moved on from Year 5/6, where instead of using simple endings, we would use twists and cliffhangers. My tutor was really helpful, and she helped me when I was needed it. 'Guiliana'
