Dear Parents and Carers,

Welcome to Term 4! As always it has been lovely catching up with students and hearing what they got up to on their holidays. It sounds like quite a few went to the Royal Melbourne Show and a few were lucky enough to take a trip overseas and enjoy some warmer weather. I would like to thank Ms Valentine for competently leading the school in my absence at the end of last term and for our Leadership Team who also took on additional roles.

This week I have spent some time in the junior classes, listening to some reading in F/1, while they were practising their fluency and hearing some poetry in the Year 2 classes. I also joined the Year 5/6 teachers observe a Maths lesson in 5/6C with our Maths consultant and expert, Margarita Breed. Students were provided with the challenge of naming the different fractions within a square provided to them. It was really rewarding to hear the discussions taking place, sharing of strategies and collaboration amongst students and their ability to verbalise their thinking with the whole class. It certainly demonstrated the progress we have made since implementing our new Maths Model and professional learning we have had with Margarita. We will continue to work with Margarita during 2025 to improve our understanding of how to provide meaningful and challenging Maths experiences and learning for our students.


