This year we want to double that!



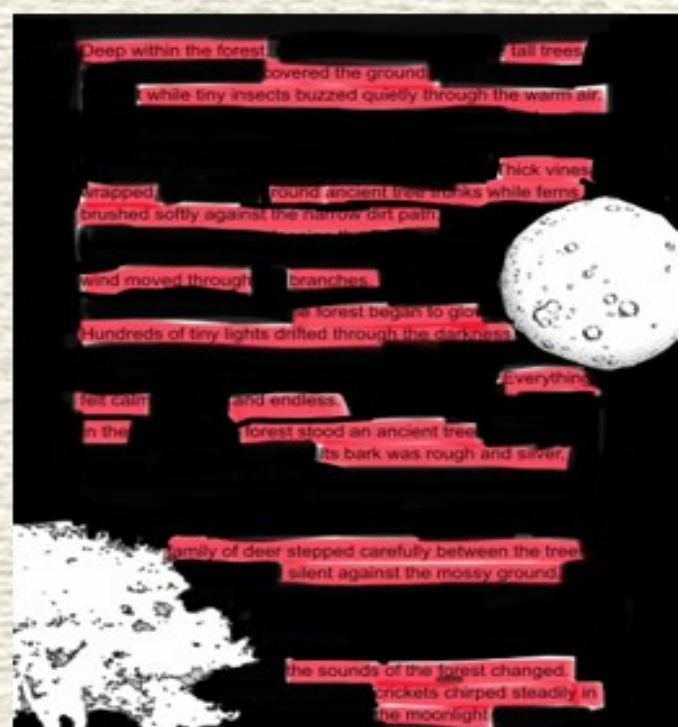
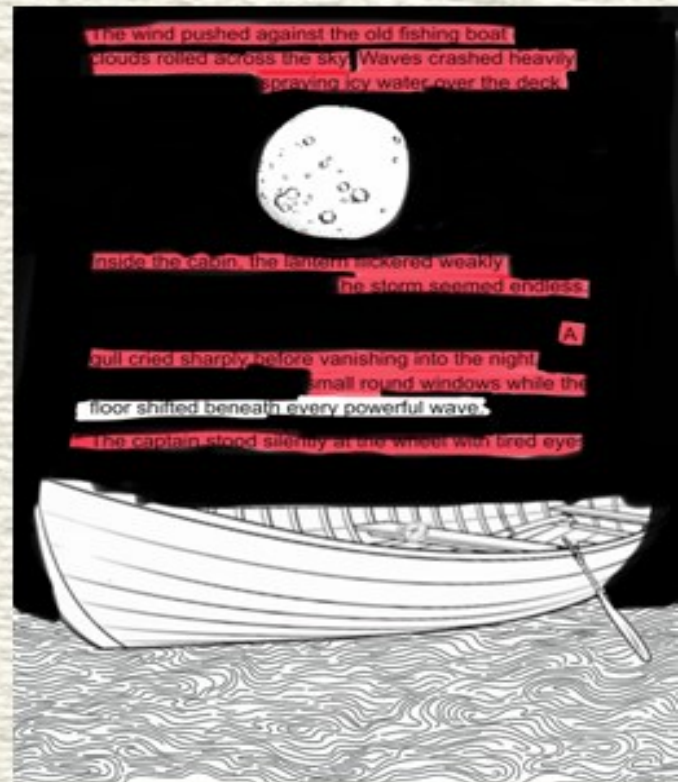
