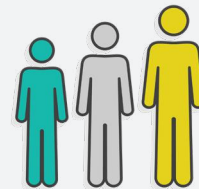
A comprehensive F-6 whole school learning program.

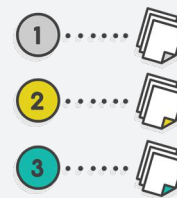

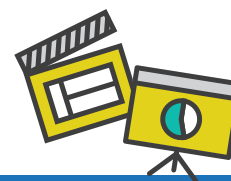

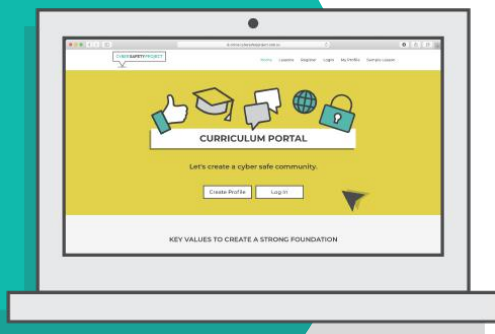

CYBER SAVVY EDUCATOR

YEAR ONE - DIGITAL SAFETY

In this session, educators will walk away with an understanding of the latest digital trends for young people today and provide an imperative to reflect on their role as an educator in the 21st Century.

The team will share fundamental strategies for teaching six key cyber safety concepts and provide educators with links to resources that can help level up their cyber safety teaching.

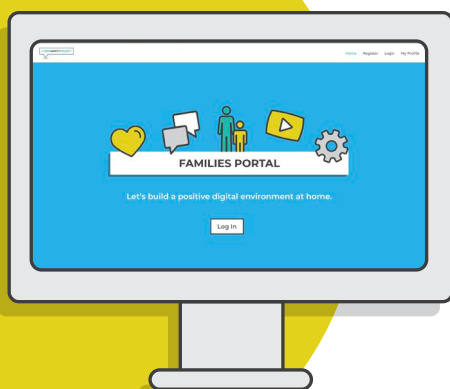

Knowledge is power so we will discuss trending platforms such as Instagram, Snapchat, TikTok and anonymous messaging platforms. You'll also gain practical tips that can be immediately implemented to keep kids safe.

TOPIC 3 KEEPING KIDS SAFE WHO GAME

Gaming today is social. It's where young people go to play, connect and communicate with their friends. This webinar will uncover the appeal of gaming and expose the way game developers encourage young people to regularly play. Throughout this workshop you'll gain practical tips for helping to manage screen time and the development of self-regulation skills in young gamers.

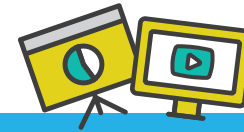

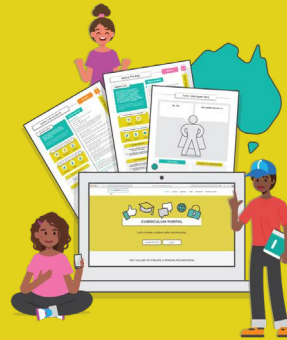
