2027 Planning

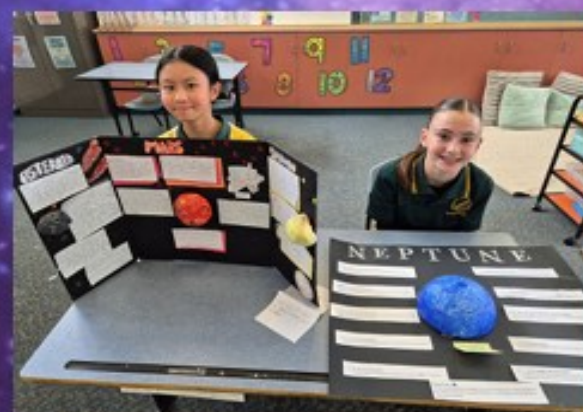
Last Day Term 3 – Early Dismissal 2.25pm

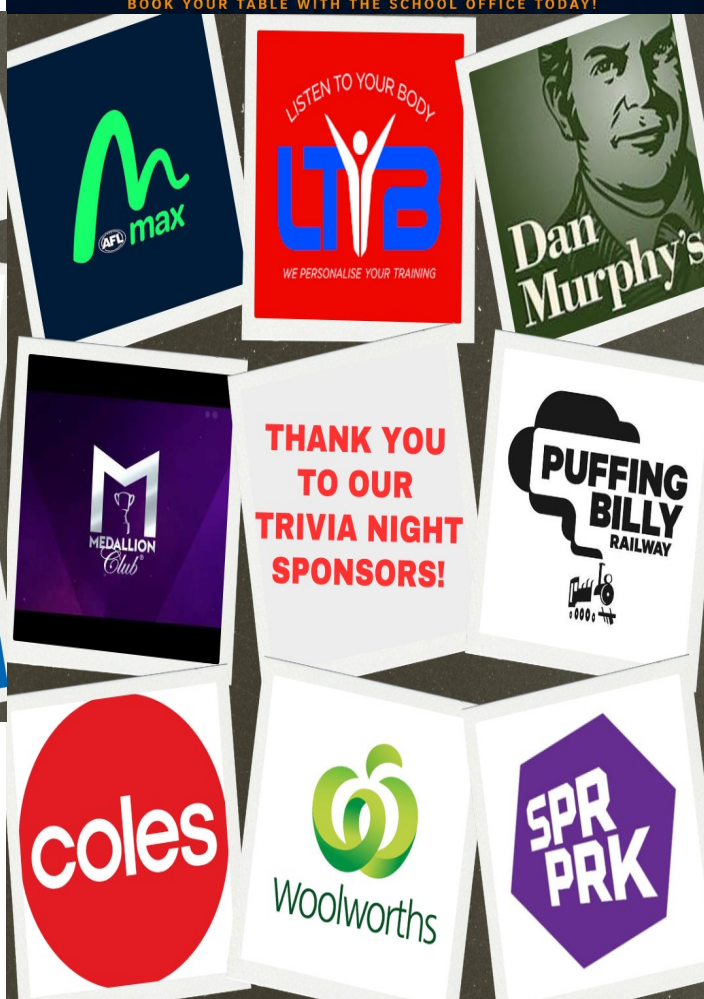
