Henry Street Works

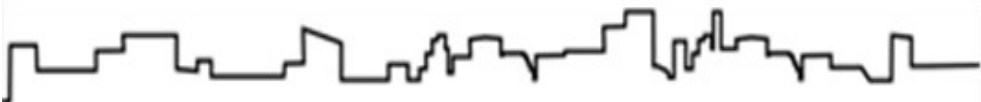
Thank you for your patience during the current road works. Western Water expect the works on Henry Street to be completed next Wednesday, however I will keep you updated as I am.

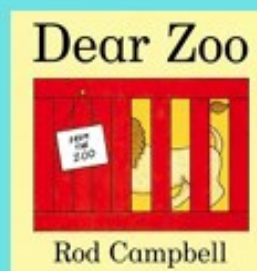
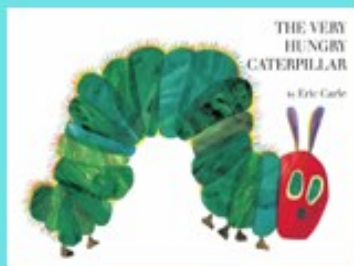

Leading up to this event you can purchase Leigh Hobbs books online from The SUN BOOKSHOP in Yarraville. Leigh will be available to sign his books on the day.



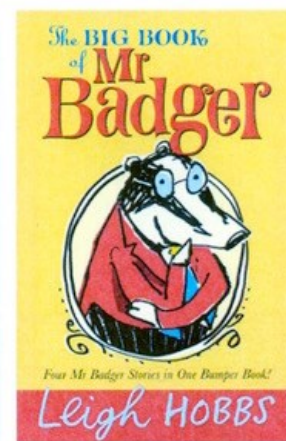
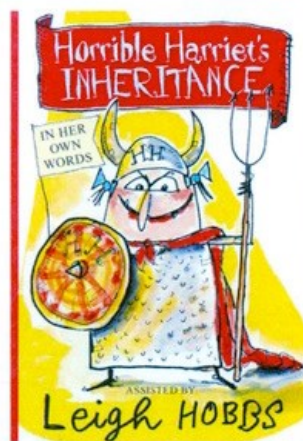
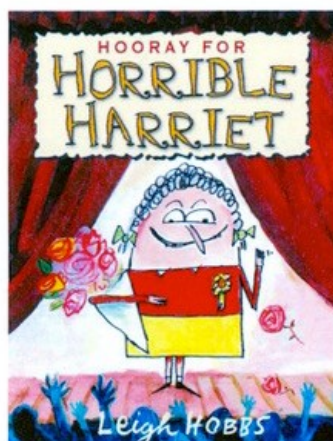
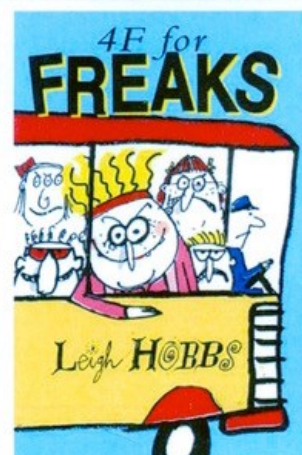
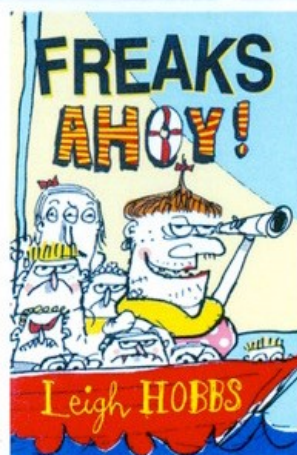
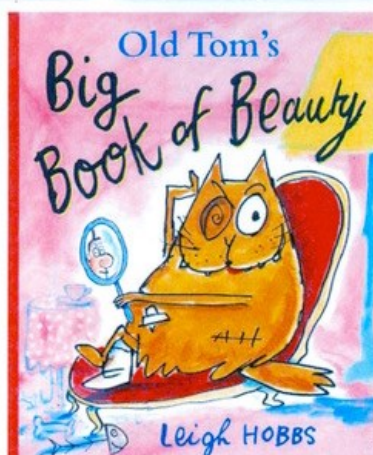
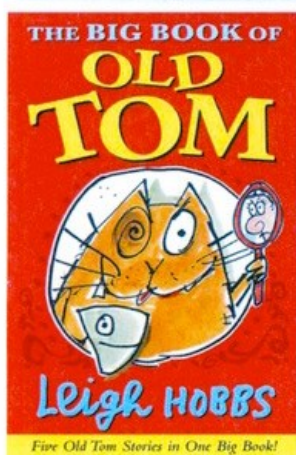
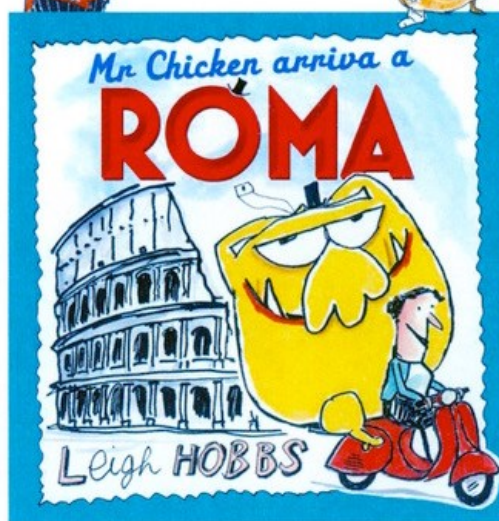
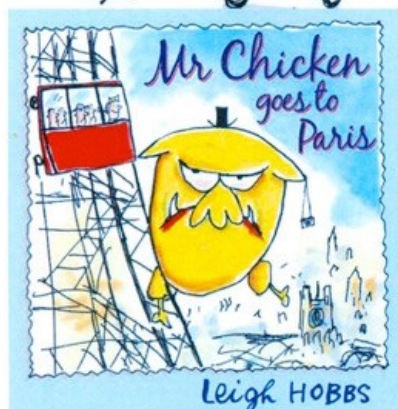
