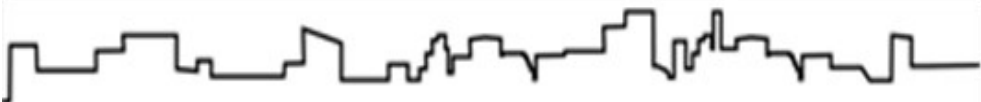

- Nimbus (stormy)

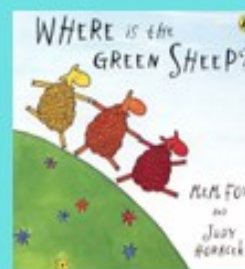
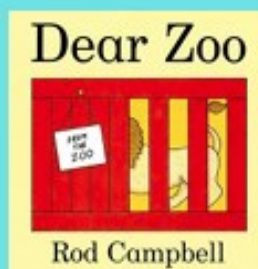
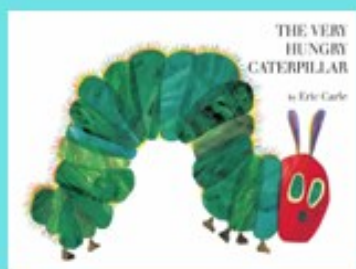
